Parent-teacher interviews will be held at the following times:

9:00am – 2.50pm Friday 14th February 2024

To book your interviews, either use the QR code above with a smartphone camera to take you directly to the booking page, or go to **www.schoolinterviews.co.nz/code** in your browser, and enter the event code **gk4qc**

Then follow these three simple steps:

A green rounded rectangle with a white number '1', an icon of two people, and the text "Enter your details".	<p>First enter your details. If you need to book for more than one student, change the "Book for x students" setting, and enter the other student's name.</p>
A green rounded rectangle with a white number '2', dropdown menus for "Year 1" (Mr Able) and "Maths" (Ms Bell), and the text "Choose teachers".	<p>On the next page, pick the teacher you want to meet.</p>
A blue rounded rectangle with a white number '3', time slots "4:30", "4:40", "4:50", and checkboxes, and the text "Choose times".	<p>Then you'll see a timetable showing when your chosen teacher is available. Simply click on the time that suits you.</p>

When you have finished, your interview timetable will be emailed to you. And you can return to the site and enter the event code **gk4qc** again to change or cancel your interviews.
