#### Parent Election Notice (notify community)

Nominations are open for the election of 5 parent representatives to the school board.

All eligible voters will receive a nomination form. Use this form to nominate yourself or someone in your community. You will also receive a nomination cover letter calling for nominations. Information on who is not eligible to be a board member is provided with this notice, and the nomination form.

If you need more nomination forms, contact the school office.

Nominations close at **noon** on Wednesday 6 August. You may provide a signed candidate statement and photograph with your nomination.

The electoral roll is held at the school and can be viewed during normal school hours.

As nominations are received, there will be a list of candidates' names kept at the school up until election day, which you can view.

Voting closes at 4pm on Wednesday 10 September, 2025.

**Signage.** Over the last few weeks we have been erecting new signage around the school that is reflective of our Te Mana o Tūtarawānanga localised curriculum. It has taken quite a long period to get to where we are but we are confident that now the signage is here, it will further enhance the essence of our kura. **Major Property Works.** The Board developed its long term property plan as set by the Ministry of Education a few years ago. This work has finally been approved for action and will take place in the next school holidays and into Term 4. **Harrison Tew Emergency Procedures.** As part of our ongoing compliance and safety process, the school will be reviewed next **Friday 8 August** by Harrison Tew. They will then formulate emergency procedures for our school. We encourage full attendance on this day as they will be giving on-site training for all students and staff. The review process will take place for most of the day.
