To remind our community again of Alert Level 2 rules, they are as follows:

- Safe hygiene practices must be followed when at school - washing hands regularly, coughing etiquette and distancing when possible.
- No one is permitted on to school grounds with the exception of students and staff. All visitors, including parents, caregivers and whānau, must check in at the office on arrival.
- When dropping off or collecting children, please wait in your vehicle or if on foot, waiting at the front entry of the school maintaining a safe distance from others.
- If you have any concerns we encourage you to contact the office.

Again, because of Level 2, there are a number of postponements and cancellations taking place not only for school based events but in the Tauranga community as well.

We have postponed Student Led Conferences until Friday 11 September and School Photos have also been postponed until further notice.
